## **Duty Statement**

The South West Music Regional Conservatorium (SWMRC) is looking for specialist music teachers to fill various teaching roles. These positions involve teaching your specialised instrument to students of all ages and abilities in individual, group and ensemble situations.

- Position Types: Casual/Part time. Hours depending on teaching schedule
- Commencement: Term One 2023 onwards
- Salary: Casual / Part time appointment

## **Position Description:**

The successful candidate will be required to:

- Teach your specialised instrument to students individually or in small groups from beginner to advanced levels.
- Work with students ranging from primary years through to adult learners.
- Encourage and prepare students for concerts, examinations and eisteddfods
- Accompany students for concerts and exams and participate in staff performances
- Teach within school programs at both public and private schools in the South West region.
- Teach in other areas, according to the applicant's range of skills and experience
- Teach at the Conservatorium in Cressy Street, Deniliquin
- Work with SWMRC staff, particularly the Head of Music and Administration Manager to promote your specialised instrument in schools and the community, to implement the SWMRC strategic plan, and to work with and expand the SWMRC's Curriculum Program.

## **Essential Criteria - Applicants must have:**

- Have experience at teaching all levels of your specialised instrument individually and in groups
- Be familiar with working within school environments.
- Hold suitable qualifications in music or education or have equivalent, demonstrable professional experience.
- Ability to contribute to planning and administration of the teaching program as required
- Be prepared to work as part of a team and to share knowledge and skills.
- A current NSW Working with Children Check Number or current Application Number.
- A current NSW Police Check or current Application Number.
- Hold a current NSW or Australian Drivers License.

## **Desirable Criteria - Applicants may have:**

- Be a professional performer with the capacity to participate in performance as a soloist and/or ensemble musician.
- Performance experience
- Hold suitable tertiary qualifications in music or education or have equivalent, demonstrable professional experience.
- Additional teaching experience in any one or more of these areas: music theory, choir, vocal, early childhood music, classroom music, or any other instrument (wind, brass, strings, guitar)
